In this role, you will:

- Facilitate group discussions on topics such as mental health, employment, relationships, resilience, and personal growth.

- Conduct professional assessments to understand client needs, including mental health, trauma, addiction, behavioural challenges, and family/relationship concerns.
- Deliver tailored therapeutic interventions to support clients in overcoming employment barriers.
- Provide referrals and liaison services with other professional providers as needed.
- Maintain accurate and comprehensive reports and intervention plans.
- Casual 2 days/week, 3-4 hours/day with view to increase.
